Spring ball: the sign ups are low in numbers so far for the spring season. EHTYS was allowed to have non-resident players to sign up for the organization just for the spring season. Hopefully after allowing that, EHT will get enough players to sustain the season. It is also decided that non-resident players cannot participate in the Allstars. Reminder, all travel players should play at the same age level as they do for their travel team.

For the travel, the coaches have to coach (head or assistance) at least one season of the rec ball (either fall or spring), also it is the head coaches' responsibility to make sure the (EHT resident) travel players have to play at least one season of rec ball to be able to participate in the F-5 travel program.

Upcoming improvements:

We need new cameras that can be ran via Ethernet to monitor Fields 3 and 4, the cameras installed on the field house are not enough to cover the surveillance on the back fields or the other storage shed. Currently found a deal \$1440 for 8 cameras that would run 4. Lamb and

Henderson agree to help bring back the golf carts. Also, we should look into getting a new golf cart.

Field 1 and Field 3 flood often, we need appropriate equipment to be able to drain them when it happens.

Upcoming purchases:

We need face masks, catchers gear, z screens, score books, helmets (that have to be replaced for the safety of the players), mounds.

The parking lot is still in a desperate need of the lights.

New battery needs to be ordered for the defibrillator.

Upcoming events: In order to help beginner pitchers and catchers, EHTYS coaches are looking to add a free pitching/catching clinic for the rec players. Devine and Gonzalez made a reference to the high school softball coach who prior inquired about any volunteer work that his HS players can get involved into helping EHTYS. After A. Gresham asked if any of the board members are willing to volunteer to run a clinic, Rymas offered to participate with an expectation of being financially compensated if she does.
